

Moroccan Dairy Sector Moves Forward with U.S. Soy

USSEC organized dairy nutrition and management workshops in Morocco to update leading dairy nutritionists and managers on the latest nutritional concepts. As the dairy sector in Morocco continues its rapid expansion, incorporation of current industry advancements increases both productivity and soy inclusion.

Two of the world's leading experts in this field, Charles Stallings from Virginia State University and Alex Bach from Barcelona, Spain, presented techniques for improved productivity through enhanced nutrition and better herd management.

USSEC efforts to improve dairy technology and increase the use of U.S. in the Moroccan dairy industry have led to the establishment of several large producers using up to 6.6 pounds of U.S. soybean meal per head daily.
