

USSEC Helps Overturn Biotech Feed Ban in Poland

The Polish feed and grain industry, working in collaboration with USSEC, succeeded in overturning a ban on the use of biotech ingredients in animal feed. The Polish Parliament ratified the ban which included a provision mandating its reassessment in 2012. USSEC Europe promoted a coordinated educational campaign that influenced key decision makers in the Polish government. The decision helps to keep this 73.5 million bushel market open to U.S. exporters.
